**Kunsttage Basel (Basel Art Days): 72 hours of art at 55 locations**

**1 – 4 September 2022**

**Thursday 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., Friday – Sunday 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.**

The third edition of *Kunsttage Basel* is coming soon: From 1 to 4 September 2022, 55 museums, galleries, exhibition rooms, and off-spaces will liven up the city and bring the artistic experience to public spaces. From Riehen to the Dreispitz area in Münchenstein, the participating institutions offer a customized, mostly free event program. The Basel region is known for collecting an extraordinarily rich and artistic offering – particularly in modern and contemporary art. The Kunsttage Basel aims to make this diversity widely visible and extensively perceptible. Original, program items – varied and created with a lot of passion – also make this year’s edition a unique experience.

### **Selected highlights of the 2022 edition**

Numerous institutions – among them Oeilles Internationales with Simon Buckley and the Gagosian gallery with Richard Artschwager – are opening their latest exhibitions Thursday evening with public viewings. During the Kunsttage Basel, the indicated artists will exclusively guide through their exhibitions in the VITRINE, von Bartha, Tony Wuethrich, and SarasinArt galleries, among others. Senam Okudzeto and Mariejon de Jong-Buijs meet in Space25 to hold a conversation. Alexandra Bachzetsis is showcasing a performance in the Baloise Park art forum, and artists from Atelier Mondial are guests at the Villa Renata with a group presentation. Among others, the Baselland @ TransBona-Halle, and the Palazzo Art Hall from Basel Country are present with a special program for the art days.

This year, many locations are now offering concerts, openings, or performances in the evening as well. The <wirdnachgereicht> project space shows a Fashion Show, and the HEK will open the “Earthbound - In Dialog with Nature” exhibition with a subsequent party. Of course, like every year, these special program items are coupled by a top-class offering of exhibitions such as “Mondrian Evolution” in the Beyeler foundation, “Picasso – El Greco” in the Basel art museum or “Anouk Kruithof. Universal Tongue” in the Tinguely museum and many others more.

### **Participative offerings**

Guided tours of several institutions of the Art Days will encourage you to mutually discover different institutions. Furthermore, for this year’s edition, numerous institutions such as the Museum of Cultures, the Mueller Gallery, pf25 cultural projects or symbiont have developed participative offerings that promote individual access to the artist experience.

### **Sharing Movements. Public projects**

Twelve select projects will be publicly displayed in this year’s Kunsttage Basel under the title “Sharing Movements”. The performances, live art events, and spatial interventions take place spread across the city area and the adjacent municipalities and take you across 15 different locations such as the rehearsal room for the symphony orchestra, the ticketing hall of the SBB train station, and central locations in the Basel city centre. The freely accessible positions of artists from different generations and backgrounds create moments of exchange and pause and get to the heart of the bond between nature and culture.
